The North American Butterfly Association (NABA) has orchestrated this program in the United States, Canada, and Mexico since 1993. According to NABA: annually published reports provide a The tremendous amount of information about the geographical distribution and relative population sizes of the species counted. Comparisons of the results across years can be used to monitor changes in butterfly populations and study the effects of weather and habitat change on North American butterflies.
